

# Announcement on the reopening of Nanjing Museum

Dear tourist friends:

Weeping willows in front of the door waited for the spring breeze, and the rain came back. Our hospital will resume opening to the public on March 19, 2020, and visitors are welcome to visit in an orderly manner. The relevant matters are now announced as follows:

1. Opening hours Tuesday to Sunday 9:00-17:00 (no admission at 16:00), closed all day every Monday (except for national legal holidays). The museum will open exhibition halls and public spaces in phases by region and depending on the situation.

2. During the epidemic, the online real-name appointment system is strictly implemented, with a daily limit of 5,000 (2,500 in the morning and 2,500 in the afternoon). Team reception and bus parking appointments will be suspended.

3. Visitors can make an appointment in advance through the Nanjing Museum's WeChat public account (see the exhibition/mini program) or the official website, choose a visit date, and swipe their ID card to enter the museum after the appointment is successful; no on-site ticket collection will be performed during the epidemic, and those who have not made an online appointment cannot Enter the exhibition hall.

4. Visitors must show their "Su Kang code" and ID card at the security checkpoint, check their body temperature, check the security items, and wear masks before they can enter the security checkpoint. If the audience does not wear a mask or has fever (body temperature  $\geq 37.2^{\circ}\text{C}$ ), cough and other symptoms, they cannot enter the exhibition hall and can enter the lounge to rest.

5. Suspend manual explanation services, educational activities, theater performances and some venue management projects. Audiences can rent smart guide equipment at the information desk of the history hall and special exhibition hall to experience self-guided tours.

6. The audience must wear masks throughout the tour. When queuing and visiting, please keep a distance of more than 1.5 meters with others to avoid crowds.

7. It is recommended that the visitor time be controlled within 2 hours to avoid crowds.

Our hospital will make every effort to implement prevention and control measures to ensure the orderly safety of opening to the outside world during the epidemic prevention and control period. We also look forward to the prevention and control work of all visitors with us, abide by the regulations,

and observe the exhibition in a civilized manner. All relevant prevention and control measures are to better protect the lives of you and your family, please understand. Thank you for your cooperation and support.
